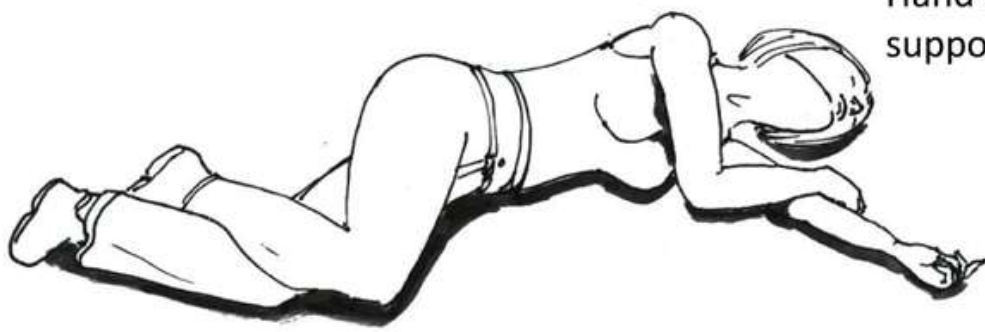


# Recognising and Responding to an opiate related overdose.

	<p><i>Response:</i> can you get a response out of them?</p> <p>Call their name and gently shake their shoulder, try to wake them up.</p>
	<p><i>No response? CALL 000 FOR HELP</i></p>
	<p>If the person is <i>not breathing</i> you need to <i>check their Airway</i>. Open their mouth and have a look. There may be vomit blocking their airway.</p> <p>If so, roll them onto their side and use your fingers to clear their airway. They may start to breathe again but if not you will need to roll them onto their back and begin rescue breathing</p>
	<p><i>Rescue breathing: two quick breaths every five seconds</i></p>



Hand should support head.

Knee prevents body from rolling on to stomach.
